


Primary Preset Function Keys


Your CyberPowerPC CK60 gaming keyboard comes with preset function keys. See the table to the right for more information on the combinations available.

Secondary Custom Function Keys

- 1. Select the "**DEVICE**" tab.
- 2. Select the "FN1 Layer" tab.


Secondary Custom Function Keys

1. Select any key to assign as your secondary function key.

Note: We recommend the "Super" key since it is not preset with any functions.

- Click on "Set FN1" to assign the selected key as your secondary function key
- You'll see that the key is now labeled "FNI"



Assigning Secondary Functions


- 1. Select any key you want to assign a secondary function to.

- Once you have completed assigning your new secondary functions, click the "Download" to update your keyboard functions.



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Creating Macros


- 1. Select the "MACRO" tab.
- 2. Select the "**Record**" tab.
- Click your macros keys to begin adding them to your recorded Macro Event.
- 4. Click "**Stop**" when the macro is complete.






Assigning Macros

- 2. Select "**Macro**" from the side navigation under "Profile"
- 3. Select the macro you created earlier from the drop-down menu
- Click "OK" to assign the macro to the selected key.
